Eager Park Concert Series / Movie Nights

City residents and Johns Hopkins affiliates have been enjoying both daytime and evening concerts in the park. In May, the Peabody Jazz Ensemble performed, and in early June, local DJ Neil Mattei kicked off Caribbean Heritage Month with curated DJ sets and live performances, drawing a crowd of over 200. Upcoming events include: afternoon Jazz concert on July 31st, Folk music afternoon concert on August 15th, evening film screenings of “Arthur the King” on July 19th and “Wish” on August 9th. Neighborhood Rally for Gun Violence Awareness

The Johns Hopkins Hospital hosted a community rally on May 29th to spotlight gun violence prevention ahead of Gun Violence Awareness Month in June. The event brought together leaders from the hospital and the East Baltimore community, including the Mayor’s Office of Neighborhood Safety and Engagement (MONSE). Rally attendees received #wearorange t-shirts for gun violence awareness. A report on WMAR featured comments from Dr. Joseph Sakran, a trauma surgeon at JHH and a survivor of gun violence himself.



Mayor’s Cleanup Event

Johns Hopkins University and Medicine sponsored the 2024 Mayor’s Spring Cleanup in Baltimore City on Saturday, April 27. We were responsible for cleaning up the Four-by-Four neighborhood in Northeast Baltimore. This site had about 85 volunteers total, including some from other organizations, who spent several hours picking up trash, weed whacking and filling dumpsters with bulk pickup items from neighbors.



Redline Press Conference

Maryland Gov. Wes Moore held a press conference at Johns Hopkins Bayview on June 28 to announce future plans for the Red Line, which will consist of light rail transit rather than a rapid bus line. The Red Line will run from the Woodlawn area in Baltimore County, through West Baltimore, to downtown, and across East Baltimore to the Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center.
