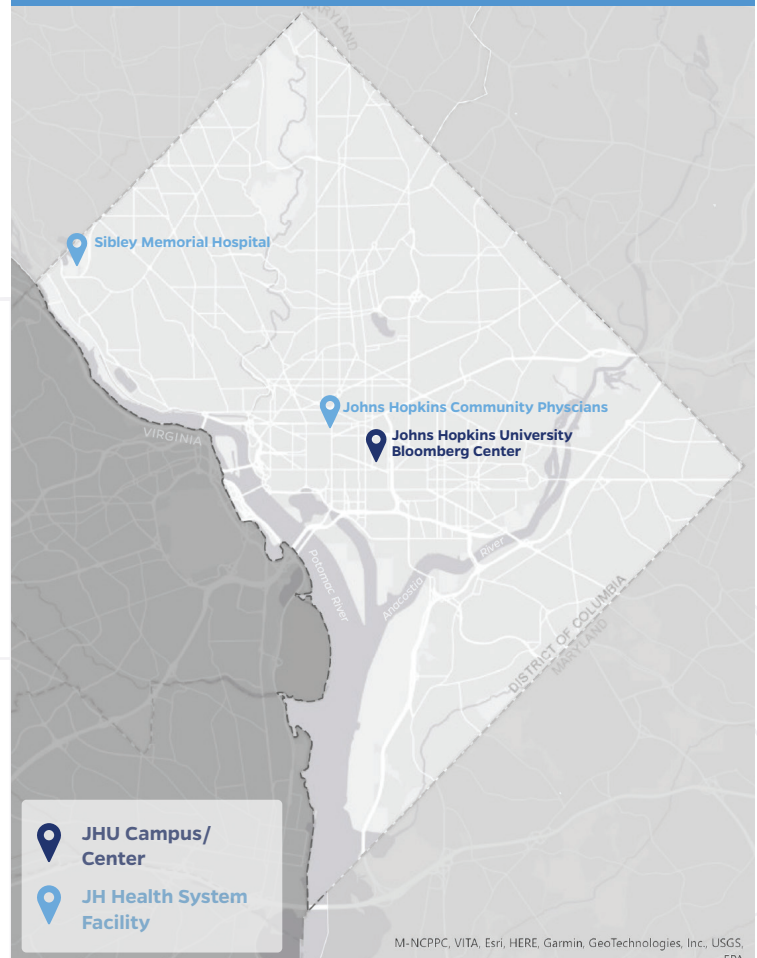

A Home for Health Care

Johns Hopkins maintains a significant presence in Washington, D.C., through both academic and healthcare facilities that serve the nation's capital. The state-of-the-art Hopkins Bloomberg Center at 555 Pennsylvania Avenue, opened in 2023, houses students and faculty from all nine academic divisions—just steps from the U.S. Capitol. Johns Hopkins Medicine also operates Sibley Memorial Hospital, a distinguished community hospital that features state-of-the-art facilities including the Johns Hopkins Kimmel Cancer Center. Together, these facilities position Johns Hopkins to inform policy discussions, amplify research impact, and deliver world-class education and healthcare to the Washington, D.C. area.
